

VISIBLE INVISIBLE FOUNDATION

STATUTE

CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

§ 1

The Foundation named "Foundation Visible Invisible" hereinafter referred to as the "Foundation" was established by the Founders:

- a. Paweł Kaczorowski
- b. Konrad Komar
- c. Lukasz Laskowski

§ 2

1. The Foundation shall operate on the basis of Polish law and these Statutes.
2. The Foundation has a legal personality.
3. The Foundation was established for an indefinite period of time.

§ 3

The Foundation's area of activity is the Republic of Poland and other countries. The Foundation may have branches, including branches abroad, and create other organizational units.

2. The seat of the Foundation is the capital city of Warsaw.
3. The Foundation may use a distinctive logo.

CHAPTER II

OBJECTIVES AND PRINCIPLES OF THE FOUNDATION

§ 4

The objectives of the Foundation are:

- a. To promote social inclusion and equality of persons with disabilities and the elderly.
- b. Promotion of technologies that assist and facilitate the daily lives of people with disabilities and the elderly.
- c. Raising public awareness of disability and acceptance of diversity.
- d. Promoting economic activity for people with disabilities and the elderly.
- e. Promotion of art created by people with disabilities and the elderly.

- f. Promotion of active participation of people with disabilities and the elderly in creating an egalitarian society.
- g. Promotion of active lifestyles of people with disabilities and the elderly.

§ 5

The Foundation pursues its objectives through:

- a. Establishing public-private partnerships to carry out statutory activities.
- b. Organizing and supporting integration projects, research, educational and promotional initiatives within the scope defined by the objectives of the Foundation.
- c. Organizing and supporting workshops, conferences and scientific-educational seminars and training programs within the scope defined by the objectives of the Foundation.
- d. Conducting information campaigns within the scope specified by the objectives of the Foundation.
- e. Maintaining an Internet portal within the scope specified by the objectives of the Foundation.
- f. Cooperating with local government units, schools, universities, non-governmental organizations, the media, entrepreneurs, and international organizations within the scope specified by the objectives of the Foundation.
- g. Providing financial or in-kind support to people with disabilities and the elderly.

CHAPTER III

ASSETS AND INCOME OF THE FOUNDATION

§ 6

The assets of the Foundation consist of its initial fund in the amount of PLN 1500.00 - (one thousand five hundred zlotys) and property acquired during the period of activity of the Foundation.

§ 7

The Foundation's income may come from:

- a. Grants and subsidies,
- b. Grants,
- c. Donations, inheritances, bequests.

Section IV

MANAGEMENT OF THE FOUNDATION

§ 8

1. The Board of the Foundation shall manage the activities of the Foundation and represent it outside.
2. The Foundation Board shall be appointed by the Founders, by means of a resolution adopted unanimously by all the Founders.
3. The Foundation Board shall consist of three members and shall be appointed for an indefinite period of time.
4. Declarations of will on behalf of the Foundation shall be made by two members of the Board of the Foundation acting jointly.

§ 9

1. The powers of the Board of the Foundation include all matters not reserved to the competence of the Founders, in particular:
 - a. Managing the current work of the Foundation and the implementation of its objectives.
 - b. Adopting annual action plans of the Foundation and financial plans.
 - c. Submitting to the Founders an annual report on the activities of the Foundation.
 - d. Managing the assets of the Foundation.
 - e. Accepting donations, bequests, legacies, subsidies and grants in the form of a statement required by law.
2. Resolutions of the Board of the Foundation shall be adopted by a simple majority of votes cast, with at least half of the members present.

§ 10

Membership in the Board of the Foundation ceases as a result of:

- a. Death.
- b. Submission of a written resignation to the Founders.
- c. Dismissal by the Founders of the Foundation by a resolution adopted unanimously by all the Founders.

CHAPTER V

AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTE

§ 11

Amendments to the objectives or the Articles of the Foundation shall be made by the Founders by means of a resolution adopted unanimously by all the Founders.

CHAPTER VI

LIQUIDATION OF THE FOUNDATION

§ 12

The decision to liquidate the Foundation shall be made by the Founders by means of a resolution adopted unanimously by all the Founders.
